TERMS

- The type of work + quality shown in your submitted images is acceptable for display / sale. The type + quality of work you submit with this application is the only work that can be sold at the fair.
- All work displayed must be original and made in North America. It must be created by you (the artist) or under your direct supervision.
- Artisans that sell food products must provide proof of General Liability insurance approved by the New England Botanic Garden. NEBG will contact vendors who need to submit an insurance certificate.
- NEBG + WCC will not be held responsible for any liability for lost, stolen, or damaged merchandise, or injury incurred during the event.

Booth size options are 8x8 ft, 8x10 ft, 10x10 ft and 12x3 ft. Pricing ranges from \$500 - \$700. Booth placement is decided by the curator. **Please indicate which size booth and let us know ahead of time if you need electricity.**
